

Accessing Additional Classroom Resources

The list below provides details on several projects and organizations you and teachers can access to secure classroom resources.

Requesting Funding for Classroom Supplies

Adopt-A-Classroom: On Adopt-A-Classroom, teachers create classroom profiles and wish-lists. Donors then adopt and fund classrooms, allowing teachers to purchase resources.

Classwish: Classwish allows teachers to create supply wish-lists and provides resources for helping schools obtain funding.

DigitalWish: DigitalWish provides schools and teachers with a variety of resources to obtain classroom technology. Some methods for obtaining technology including crowd-funding, discounts, and grant resources.

DonorsChoose.org: On this site, teachers post classroom needs to be funded by donors. According to DonorsChoose.org, 48% of public schools in America have teachers with classroom accounts, and 70% of classroom projects are fully funded.

Obtaining Classroom Grants and Private Partnerships

Many small grants exist for classroom resources and some corporate initiatives also offer classroom supplies.
