DATA AVAILABILITY

Data for this analysis is obtained from two sources. First, teacher diversity data is obtained from state departments of education. Second, student diversity data is sourced from the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES).

Charter and Specialized Schools: Special considerations are made for certain types of schools. Charter school data is integrated into the analysis when available, specifically when the charter school was located within the boundaries of the host district. Data for specialized schools such as adult education, pre-K, regional schools, prison-based schools, schools serving deaf and blind students, and virtual schools are rarely available but included if available.

One-Year Data Gap: In instances where there is a one-year gap in data for a particular school or district, imputation rules are applied. If it is known to be in operation and missing data for a specific year, student or teacher counts by race/ethnicity are assumed to be the same as in the following year.
